





# **Beyond Borders**



1 in every 4 students of UGC-funded programmes are from outside of Hong Kong, with over 26 600 non-local students out of a total of more than 110 000 students



Over 77 000 non-local students enrolled in programmes at UGC-funded universities, including self-financing programmes



Students from over 100 countries enrolled in more than 200 UGC-funded undergraduate degree programmes



Around 70% of academic staff are from outside of Hong Kong



# **Global Student Exchange Network**

#### Broadening students' horizons best prepare them future success

Over 2 600 student exchange agreements worldwide signed by the eight UGC-funded universities in 2024/25





- In 2023/24, the number of **incoming exchanges** amounted to about **5 100** while the number of **outgoing exchanges** was about **5 500**
- Over 60% of incoming students from North America and Europe

# **World Leading Research**

### **Extraordinary Research Excellence**

- Hong Kong's publicly funded universities have attained remarkable research excellence, as recognised by international peer reviews
- In the 2020 Research Assessment Exercise (RAE 2020):
  - Over 16 000 research submissions evaluated by over 360 international experts
- 70% of submissions rated "internationally excellent" or "world-leading"

### **Profound Research Impact**

- 345 impactful case studies submitted to RAE 2020, with 80% recognised for "outstanding" or "considerable" impact
- Breakthrough discoveries and innovations spanning diverse fields, including public policy, business, health, education, social welfare, environment, technology, and more

# **Unwavering Pursuit of Excellence**

- This encouraging result serves as compelling evidence of the universities' research prowess
- Provides valuable guidance for their continuous pursuit of research excellence





#### Top-notch Research Environment

- Hong Kong universities' research environment conducive to producing "world-leading" or "internationally excellent" research
- · Validated by the RAE 2020
- 81% of submissions received the two highest gradings

- Widespread external recognition


#### Impactful Research Collaborations Worldwide

### Record-high Salary

Graduates of full-time UGC-funded undergraduate programmes recorded an average salary of HK\$329,000 (about US\$42,000) in 2023/24

### **Extended Post-graduation Work Authorisation for Non-local Graduates**

Non-local graduates may leverage up to 2 years of post-graduation work authorisation in Hong Kong, with flexibility to extend visa with employer sponsorship



# **Abundant Scholarships and Funding Opportunities**

- The Belt and Road Scholarship by the Government of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region
- Over 700 scholarship schemes for students from outside Hong Kong by the eight UGC-funded universities



• RGC fellowship schemes

- Hong Kong PhD Fellowship Scheme (HKPFS)
- > Through the HKPFS, Hong Kong's outstanding universities offer exciting research opportunities in a broad range of PhD programmes, with generous stipends and excellent support, for the best and brightest students from around the world.
- > The Fellowship provides an annual stipend of HK\$340,800 (approximately US\$43,690) and a conference and researchrelated travel allowance of HK\$14,200 (approximately US\$1,820) per year for each awardee for a period up to three years. There are 400 fellowship award places in each academic year.

- RGC Research Fellow Scheme
- RGC Senior Research Fellow Scheme
- Humanities and Social Sciences Prestigious Fellowship Scheme
