The year 2021-22 was a challenging year for Hong Kong and its higher education sector, with waves of COVID-19 resurgences persisted. Yet, throughout these trying times, our universities have demonstrated resilience in addressing these challenges. In fact, our university colleagues not only successfully delivered exceptional teaching and research by continuously embracing innovative virtual learning strategies, but also contributed immensely to the government's infectious diseases prevention and control endeavors. They have truly showcased their unwavering commitment to serving the community. The UGC would like to pay tributes to all in the higher education sector for holding the fort throughout this hard battle.

Notwithstanding the challenges, the flagship initiatives of the UGC have achieved fruition. The UGC concluded the Planning Exercise for the 2022-23 to 2024-25 triennium (2022-25 triennium) and submitted our recommendations to the Government in October 2021, which culminated in the Government's approval of the triennial funding of \$63.2 billion for the eight UGC-funded universities in January 2022. In the current round of the Planning Exercise, the Government has identified four Strategic Directions for the UGC-funded sector in the 2022-25 triennium. The UGC has accordingly taken up a more proactive role in guiding universities to better fulfill the policy objectives and societal needs in their academic planning for the next three years. We have also adopted a more data-driven approach in this Planning Exercise for a more systematic, fair and transparent mechanism. We hope that our universities could continue to nurture talents who possess knowledge in different fields so as to synergise Hong Kong's various advantages and further strengthen our competitiveness.

儘管面對挑戰,教資會的主要舉措 仍然取得令人鼓舞的成果。教資會 已完成 2022-23 至 2024-25 三年期 (2022-25 三年期) 規劃工作,並 於 2021 年 10 月向政府提交建議, 最終政府於2022年1月批准為八 所教資會資助大學提供632億元 的三年期撥款。在本輪的規劃工作 中,政府就 2022-25 三年期為教資 會資助界別訂出了四個策略方向, 並由教資會擔當積極角色,引領大 學在未來三年的學術規劃中更佳地 回應政策目標和社會需求。教資會 亦進一步採用數據為本的方法,以 更有系統、公平和透明的機制進行 規劃工作。我們期望各大學能繼續 培養具備不同範疇知識的專才,以 發揮香港的各項優勢,進一步鞏固 香港的競爭力。

On student support, riding on the remarkable achievements attained by our outstanding athletes in the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games, Tokyo 2020 Paralympic Games and the 14th National Games, as well as the announcement that Hong Kong will cohost the 15th National Games with Guangdong and Macao in 2025, the UGC launched the Student-Athlete Learning Support and Admission Scheme (SALSA Scheme) in early 2022 to support outstanding athletes who aspire to pursue dual-track career developments in the eight UGC-funded universities in the 2022-25 triennium. The scheme has been a great success in assisting outstanding student-athletes to pursue both their academic studies and their athletic careers.

On research, the public release of the Research Assessment Exercise (RAE) 2020 results in May 2021 has been a most celebrated achievement on the quality of Hong Kong's academic research. The encouraging results once again highlighted the world-class standing of our universities' research performance, which has grown from strength to strength compared with six years ago. These results are also a testament to the hard work and commitment of our outstanding researchers' dedication to excellence over the years. In addition, the UGC and Research Grants Council (RGC) launched the second round COVID-19 and Novel Infectious Disease Research Exercise under the Collaborative Research Fund (CRF). The funded projects straddled over social, economic, engineering, business and humanities disciplines. We look forward to their contributions to the betterment of society.
