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2022 UGC Teaching Award Presentation Ceremony

The annual UGC Teaching Award was introduced since 2011 to honour those who excel in teaching in the UGC sector. The Award recognises not only past and present achievements, but also leadership in and scholarly contribution to teaching and learning. The awardees are expected to become "ambassadors of good teaching" and collectively make a real and sustained impact in promoting teaching excellence. A total of 20 nominations were received from UGC-funded universities for the 2022 Award. They were assessed by an expert Selection Panel with both local and non-local members. Starting from 2022, each recipient was awarded a grant of \$750,000, up from \$500,000 in previous years, including \$675,000 for undertaking learning and teaching initiatives for the benefit of their own universities and the entire sector, and a cash award of \$75,000. The 2022 UGC Teaching Award Presentation Ceremony was held on 26 September 2022.

Hong Kong Teaching Excellence Alliance

To further emphasise the importance of quality teaching and deepen the impact of the UGC Teaching Award, the UGC initiated the establishment of the HKTEA in 2019 with the provision of an annual funding to support its operation. The HKTEA serves as a network for UGC Teaching Award Fellows to collectively make a sustained impact in promoting teaching excellence within and beyond the UGC sector. It allows academics to bond and exchange excellent teaching ideas and provides opportunities for collaboration across disciplines and institutions. To further strengthen support for HKTEA, the annual funding amount has increased from \$ 1 million to \$1.2 million starting from 2022. In 2022-23, the HKTEA continued to facilitate webinars and online workshops on different topics. It also organised a gala dinner to provide valuable opportunities for sharing of good practice, professional development and strengthening the bonds within the teaching community.

香港高等教育卓越教學聯盟

為進一步強調優質教學的重要性和深化教資會傑出教學獎的影響力，教資會於2019年倡議成立高卓聯，並每年提供撥款支持其運作。高卓聯作為教資會傑出教學獎同仁的網絡，致力於教資會界別內外合力為推廣卓越教學發揮持久的影響力。學者藉此網絡建立聯繫，就卓越教學交流意見，以及提供跨學科和跨院校的合作機會。由2022年起，撥款由每年100萬元增加至120萬元。在2022-23年度，高卓聯繼續舉辦了多場有關不同主題的網絡研討會和線上工作坊，以及周年晚宴，提供了寶貴的分享良好實踐、專業發展及加強教學界之間聯繫的機會。

Meeting with the Chief Executive

As an annual tradition, the Chief Executive, Mr John Lee, met members of the UGC on 13 January 2023 to exchange views on the latest development of higher education in Hong Kong. The Secretary for Education, Dr Christine Choi, and the Secretary for Innovation, Technology and Industry, Professor Sun Dong, also joined the meeting.

The UGC Chairman, Mr Tim Lui, briefed Mr Lee on the UGC's strategies and initiatives in nurturing talents and integrating into national development, promoting whole-person development and encouraging students to broaden their international exposure and set sights on Mainland opportunities, as well as telling the good stories of Hong Kong. He highlighted that the UGC would continue to support the universities in contributing to Hong Kong's development as an international innovation and technology hub under the National 14th Five-Year Plan. He also thanked the Government for the significant investment in higher education, which has ensured the continuing success of Hong Kong's universities in making outstanding achievements.

Mr Lee welcomed overseas members of the UGC for attending the meeting in person in Hong Kong for the first time since 2020. Mr Lee expressed his gratitude to the UGC for serving its bridging role between the Government and universities, and supporting the higher education sector's continued efforts together in striving for excellence, nurturing talents for Hong Kong's development and leveraging their strengths in research. He encouraged the UGC to continue guiding the universities in striving to achieve the Government's targets of promoting STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, the Arts and Mathematics) education and subjects related to Hong Kong's development into the "eight centres" under the National 14th Five-Year Plan, thereby supporting Hong Kong's contribution to national development in the years to come.
