## **RAE2020**

- Part of UGC's commitment to assessing universities' research performance
- Sixth such exercise to assess the quality of research using international benchmarks
- Encourage world-class research and drive excellence
- Inform the allocation of part of the research portion of recurrent block grants in a publicly accountable manner



## RAE 2020 Major Principles

- International standards: Criterion-referenced against international standards of research excellence
- Fairness: Quality of submission judged on its own merit, all types of research treated equally
- Consistency: Expert review applying the same quality standards across and within panels
- Inclusiveness: Measures the quality of a broad range of research
- Differentiation: Measures research quality of universities by unit of assessment, not individual staff, in a comparable discipline



## **RAE 2020** Assessment Elements

- New elements of research assessment on impact and environment
  - Research outputs (70%)
  - Impact (15%) incentivise conduct of research of broader social relevance with high economic and social benefit
  - Environment (15%) assess how universities' strategy, resources and infrastructure support research



## **RAE 2020** Assessment Period

- Census date: 30 September 2019
- Assessment period of six years for research outputs, impact and environment
  - 1 October 2013 to 30 September 2019
- Period of about 20 years for underpinning research of impact cases
  - 1 January 2000 to 30 September 2019



## **RAE 2020** Assessment Panels

- 13 RAE panels
- 41 units of assessment (UoAs)
- Total panel size around 360 (20% increase)
- Majority (about 70%) of panel membership including Convenors and Deputy Convenors will be non-local from outside Hong Kong



## RAE 2020 Staff Eligibility

- Academics from *Professor* to *Assistant Lecturer*
- Full-time paid appointment, wholly funded by the university proper, for a continuous period of at least 36-month covering the census date 30 September 2019
- Employment starts no later than 1 September 2017
- Special consideration/exemption may be granted on exceptional/compassionate ground



## **RAE 2020** Research Outputs

- Four research outputs per eligible academic
- Staff granted with special consideration/ exemption may reduce item(s)
- New researchers may submit fewer item(s) (first full-time appointment within 50 months before census date)
- Inter-disciplinary / Non-traditional / Non-English outputs to be indicated by universities
- Double-weighting of outputs may be requested



## RAE 2020 Research Impact

#### Definition:

- demonstrable contributions, beneficial effects, valuable changes or advantages
  - that research qualitatively brings to the economy, society, culture, public policy or services, health, the environment or quality of life
  - whether locally, regionally or internationally; and that are beyond academia



## **RAE 2020** Research Environment

#### Definition:

- strategy, resources (e.g. grants obtained, people) and infrastructure that support research
- giving rise to collaborations, esteem and contributions to the discipline or research base
- may relate to a single coherent faculty, and equally to multiple departments



## **RAE 2020** Assessment Results

- Overall quality profiles and sub-profiles of individual elements of assessment will be published by UoA and by panel at university level and sectorwide level
- Same set of results will be released to universities and the public
- Results in respect of research outputs at research area level will be provided to universities under confidential cover
- Impact submissions of universities will be made public after release of results



## RAE 2020 Submissions

- 31 July 2019: requests for special consideration/ exemption for individual staff members
- 2 December 2019: list of eligible staff and list of non-eligible full-time academic staff
- 16 December 2019:
  - university's research strategy statement
  - research outputs (full version and details)
  - impact (overview statements and case studies)
  - environment (overview statements and data)



## RAE 2020 Work Plan

- Sep 2018: Announcement of General Panel Guidelines and Panel-specific Guidelines on Assessment Criteria and Working Methods
- 30 Sept 2019: Census date
- 16 Dec 2019: Submissions by universities
- Jan-Feb 2020: Trial assessment
- Mar-Jul/Aug 2020: Assessment of submissions
- Aug-Sept 2020: Panel meetings
- Nov 2020: Panel feedback reports
- Jan 2021: Approval and announcement of RAE results
