RAE Objectives

- Assessing universities' research performance using international standard
- Promote world-class research and drive excellence
- Provide guidance for universities' developments in respect of pursuing research excellence
- Inform allocation of part of UGC Recurrent Grant




Assessment Period

- Census date: 30 September 2025
- Assessment period: six years of Research Outputs, Impact and Environment
 - 1 October 2019 to 30 September 2025
 - for impact, underpinning research carried out from 1 January 2006 to 30 September 2025



Assessment Panels



41 units of assessment (UoAs)

- > total panel size around 400
- local participation
- > international members
- Convenors/Deputy Convenors

Assessment Panels - Composition

- Academic Members (local and non-local scholars or experts);
- Lay Members (local research end-users or members of professional bodies / learnt societies);
- At least one "Inter-disciplinary champion";
- If necessary, supplemented by engaging:
 - External Reviewers;
 - Impact Assessors.



Staff Eligibility



- Academics from Professor to Assistant Lecturer
- Full-time paid appointment, wholly funded by the university proper, at least 36-month continuously covering the census date 30.9.2025
- Employment starts no later than 1.9.2023

Can be included in the IM and EN elements




Research Outputs (ROs)





Other highlights in RAE 2026

Research Impact (IM)

- Continued impact case studies (GN#7.5)
 - the body of underpinning research is the same as in the RAE 2020 case study;
 - broad overlap in the impact types and beneficiaries of what was submitted in RAE 2020 is shown, but now going distinctly beyond that, and possibly also expanding the range of impact types and/or beneficiaries.


